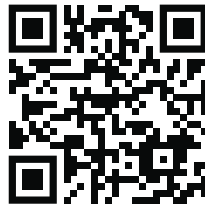


Five Tips for Results Day and Clearing 2025



1. Listen to The Uni Guide Podcast

2. Consider your options

Before calling a university Clearing team, we recommend you research the following:

- Your preferred courses at different universities
- Dual or joint degrees, where you study one subject with another. Or Foundation course options that lead to your desired degree.

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3. Know your why

Clearing teams may ask why you are interested in your chosen course at their university. Don't worry too much about your answers. The Clearing team will know you are calling on a busy day without time for detailed research.

Speak from your heart, offer your personal thoughts about the subject, and briefly share your interest in their university. You may wish to prepare a few lines using the space below.

4. Prepare for your Clearing calls

Clearing teams will ask you to provide the information below. Complete this template, then keep this with you during your phone calls, so you are ready to provide your answers. Remember: Universities will need to speak directly with you about your application. This is unless you have taken steps to authorise someone else to call on your behalf.
